

Governor Carney's Statement on Christina Board's Vote to Approve Memorandum of Understanding

WILMINGTON, Del. – Governor John Carney on Tuesday released the following statement on the Christina Board of Education's vote to approve a Memorandum of Understanding to invest in Christina's Wilmington schools:

For the past several months, we have worked in partnership with Christina School District leaders, the Board, and Christina Education Association on a plan to invest new resources in these schools, and give students in the City of Wilmington a greater chance to succeed. We are committed to working with Christina educators, district leaders, students and families to implement this agreement in a way that truly improves outcomes for children in Christina's city schools.
