



SPECIAL NOTICE TO VOTERS WHO WERE AUTOMATICALLY REGISTERED TO VOTE AT DMV (AVR VOTERS)

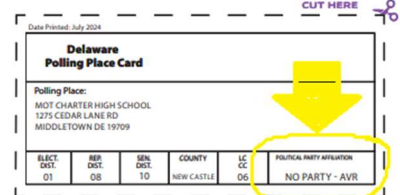
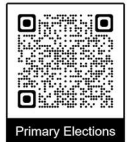
AVR Voters may declare their political party affiliation at an Early Voting Site or at their assigned Polling Place in order to vote in the 2024 State Primary Election, per Delaware law.

- Automatic Voter Registration (AVR) is a process outlined in Delaware law (15 Del. C. § 2050A) and implemented in late June 2023, through which eligible Delaware residents are automatically registered to vote at DMV and voter registration records are automatically submitted to the Department of Elections. Details on automatic voter registration are here: <https://de.gov/AVR>.
- Automatically Registered Voters (AVR Voters) are registered by the Department of Elections with No Party affiliation (NO PARTY – AVR) and are registered as of the date of their DMV transaction.
- The Department of Elections mails each automatically registered voter a “Notice of Automatic Voter Registration”, which includes a “Response to Automatic Voter Registration” form. AVR voters may use the form to update their voter registration, choose a party affiliation, or cancel their voter registration.
- AVR voters may choose a political party through the day of the first primary election following their automatic voter registration at DMV in order to vote in that primary election. For this year that date is September 10, 2024. Delaware is a closed primary state. Only voters registered with the Democratic or Republican Party may vote in their party’s primary election.



The Department encourages voters to check their party affiliation and eligibility to vote in the Primary Election by using the following Department voter resources:

- State Primary Election information including details on voter eligibility requirements is available at <https://de.gov/prim>.
- Check your voter registration record on the State of Delaware voter portal, <https://ivote.de.gov>.
- Check the party affiliation listed in the Polling Place Card section of the purple voter information mailer you received from the Department of Elections in August.
- Contact the Department of Elections Office in your county and check your party affiliation listed on your voter registration record.
